To "flip the script" is a phrase that means to reverse a particular situation by doing something unexpected and extraordinary. That's what Jesus did for all who call him Lord and Savior. He flipped the script by rising from the dead, "far as the curse is found." Happy Resurrection Day!

When Jesus Rose From The Dead, He:

1. Flipped our Eden and Virtue.

The First Salome - Herod's Daughter (Mk 6:21-24)

The Second Salome - A Witness to the Empty Tomb (Mk 16:1-4)

2. Flipped our Message.

First Messenger (John the Baptist) - What God was about to do (Mk 1:1-3, 6) Second Messenger (Angel at Tomb) - What God has done (Mk 16:5-6)


3. Flipped our Method.

Before Resurrection - Commanded secrecy and proclamation was disobedience (Mk 1:44)

After Resurrection - Commanded proclamation and secrecy is disobedience (Mk 16:7-8)

4. Flipped our Value.

Peter Two Days Before - Asleep, distant, cursing Mk 14:37; 54; 71) Peter on Easter Sunday - Must be told (Mk 16:7)
