## Message from Pastor Derrick

### How Will the Phoenix Rise? 8 Questions We're Scared to Ask #6 Job 42: 1-12a

(1) With a New Perspective (on Experiencing Life, Faith, and God).

(a) Neither bad preaching (Eliphaz, Bildad, Zophar, Derrick) or good preaching (Elihu) helped Job attain knowledge of God. That can only come through tasting and seeing that the Lord is good on the mountaintop and also in the valley.

(b) Hearing about God and Experiencing Him are Two Different Things

### (2) With a New Mission (Rescue the Perishing Who Profess to Be Wise in Their Own Estimation) 42:7-9

- (a) God was going to deal with Job's friends in their foolishness if two things didn't happen: (1) They made no sacrifice; (2) They had no high priest to offer a satisfactory prayer of expiation.
- (b) The kindness of Job to those who committed great grievances against him was the only thing that could lead them towards repentance.
- (c) Job was their high priest and mediator before God Jesus is ours.
- (d) So don't tell people Jesus loves them unless you're ready to love them also.

### (3) With a New Blessing (Restoration/Double Portion) 42:10-12a

- (a) Reason 1: We hold back blessings when we don't forgive Job did and blessings came.
- (b) Reason 2: God didn't suddenly become gracious to Job; he was that way all along.
- (c) Reason 3: Because now Job correctly understood how to value the things God gave him

### (4) With a New Testimony (God may withdraw his favor for a season; but his love will last a lifetime)

Blessed is he who fears the Lord; who finds delight in his commands. (Psalm 112:1)

For the Lord God is a sun and shield; he bestows favor and honor on those who delight in him. No good thing does he withhold from those who walk uprightly. (Psalm 84:11)

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. (Rom 8:28)

Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. (Phil 1:6)
