Part 2: Saul 2 Paul What is Your Name?

When God began a new work in someone's life, he often changed that person's name. Abram became Abraham when he believed and obeyed. Jacob became Israel when he actually told the truth for once in his life. Simon became Peter when he took Jesus at his word and believed him.

In the book of Acts, Luke shifts his focus from Saul the Persecutor to Paul the Apostle for one reason: grace had changed him and now he was going to tell the whole Roman world about it.


