Caring About What God Cares About An Exposition of Romans #7 Romans 9-10

For centuries, preachers and theologians have suggested that Romans 9-11 are the hardest three chapters in the Bible for non-Jewish Christians to understand. They might be; but I love them. Here's why: the unifying theme in all three is caring about issues that God cares about. For Paul, it was wrestling with why his fellow Jews rejected Jesus. For you and me, the issues God wants us to care about might be different. But here's what I want you to be mindful of today: If we never stop to ask ourselves if we really care about the things that God cares about, then how can we honestly call ourselves followers of Jesus?

Lessons I've Learned About It:

- 1. When you set your mind to pray, God will come and share His heart with you (9: 1-2)
 - a. Examples (Daniel; Nehemiah)
 - b. Principles
 - i. A word from the Lord is usually born in anguish.
 - ii. Don't expect to "hear" from God when there is no sign of anguish and barely any prayer
 - iii. True joy and direction in life is born out of anguish
- 2. Jesus cares the most about restoring what is broken. So must we if we call him Lord and Savior (9:3-5)
 - a. From an Old Eden to a New Eden is all of our Christian testimony
 - Making even the smallest effort to restore what's painful to restore connects my story to God's.
 - The reverse is also true.
- 3. When God doesn't meet the expectations you project upon Him, change your demanding approach to a dependent one (9:30-33).
 - a. A Demanding Attitude "Saul" Blinded by his own arrogance
 - b. A Dependent Attitude "Paul" Being humbled gave him a clearer purpose
- 4. At some point in your life, you will be the only Jesus someone will ever see (10:14-16)
 - a. There is great delight in heaven when a sinner turns from turmoil and pain
 - b. God will orchestrate your feet to march in that person's direct



One More Thing...

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! (Philippians 4:4).

Even when you cannot feel any joy, there is no spring in your step, nor any comfort or encouragement in your life, continue to rejoice and "consider it pure joy" (James 1:2). Do you believe that your heavenly Father will let you carry the banner of His victory and joy to the very front of the battle, only to calmly withdraw to see you captured or beaten back by the enemy?
