An Exposition of Romans #2
Romans 3:9-27

### Gospel Principle #2:

Heaven is God's abode; righteousness means perfectly good, just and holy. Nothing in heaven can be anything less than perfectly good, just and holy. And that poses a problem with only one solution for you and me.

### The Problem

- 1. Perfect for Heaven is God's standard for evaluating me (10-12).
- 2. Perfect for Heaven isn't what I think of when evaluating me (13-18).
- 3. Striving to be Perfect for Heaven only reveals I'm Imperfect for Heaven (20).
