A Message from Pastor Derrick

A Prayer for Direction For This Reason, I Kneel #5 Colossians 1:9-14

Thirty questions. That's the limit each kid in my household gets each day. I usually cut them off after that. "Usually," I say, because there are two questions they can always ask...even if only God knows the answer:

- 1. "What does God want me to do in my life or in a certain situation?"
- 2. "How can I please him?"

While I can show them verses, the ultimate answers to those questions are only found when they take them to the Lord in prayer.

What about you? Is there a certain situation that has developed in your life where you could use a little or a lot of direction from the Lord? We all do. And Paul's prayer for the Colossians teaches us how to be eech God for that direction in 1:9-14.

A Prayer for Direction:

- 1. Will you give me the courage to first pass your examination, Oh Lord? (1:9)
 - Like Jesus, failing the examination of others is the first step in discerning his will (Mark 8:31)
 - When that happens, you begin to fear God more than man and become useful for his purposes (Noah; Abraham; Joseph; Barnabas)
- 2. What will make you smile in this situation, Oh Lord? (1:10-11a)
 - · If I take a direction, what fruit will it yield?
 - And what action will be exercised?
- 3. What will better develop my character, Oh Lord? (1:11b-12)
 - · Endurance seeing something to the finish, regardless of time
 - · Patience tolerate delays, troubles, and sufferings without "seeing red"
 - · Joy an inward disposition that produces external gratitude and optimism
- 4. What action will advance the Gospel and Build your Kingdom, Oh Lord (1:13-14)
 - I Was Sinking Deep In Sin, Far from the Peaceful Shore
 - Thou Mine Inheritance, Now and Always


