# A Message from Pastor Derrick

Body Language An Exposition of Romans #9 Romans 12:3-8

Paul, the writer of half of your NT, understood Body Language. But the kind he understood had nothing to do with smiles and grins. Rather, it had everything to do with how the community that was the church in Rome related to each other. So it is with us, the body of Christ.

#### Good Body Language:

1. Begins with a fair and sober estimation of yourself (3)

The Reason for Estimation - More connected; yet more alone than ever Too High an Estimation - Nothing in me I can't trust Too Low an Estimation - Nothing in me I can trust Right Estimation - Confidence without conceit in proportion to faith

2. Grasps full picture of how God non-verbally communicates with the world (4)

Human Body is Unified - Needs of individual parts not in competition Human Body is Diverse - Every part must be itself; allows others to be also Human Body is Mutual - Each part belongs to other and needs each other

3. Confesses that a chasm exists between unity and uniformity (5)

Uniformity - same/exactness in form, mannerisms, thought, convictions
Uniformity - required only when diversity would produce heresy
Unity - harmony that values differences
Unity - requires grace, unlike uniformity
Unity - real people have quirks and you choose to love anyway = real relationships

4. My responsibility to be a gift to community and then to the world (6-8)

Giftedness with gracefulness is a delight to watch in action Spiritual Gift = any ability empowered by the Spirit used to build body in image of the Gift-Giver.



# Our Textbook

2 Timothy 3:10-17

You and I know there are many people in the world who reject the Bible's authority. But have you considered that some of them are Christians? Many believers unwittingly do this when they choose which parts of the Bible to believe and which parts to throw out.

But the truth is that the Bible is the very Word of God-spoken to and through His messengers, passed down through time, and relevant to every generation. It's God's magnificent revelation of Himself to the world, and everything He said was intentional.

We cannot break up Scripture or pull pieces out of context without the risk of altering its meaning. In 2 Timothy 3:16, we read that every word of the Bible is God-breathed and valuable. That means no part of it was written without a specific purpose, so whatever portion we're reading, we should pay attention to surrounding verses, the book's intended audience, and historical context.

Do you ever choose which parts of the Bible you want to believe and follow? Let's bravely ask the Holy Spirit to show us any sections of Scripture we may have thrown aside—and to help us trust in the authority of God's Word.
