


A Message from Pastor Derrick

What Has Jerusalem to do with Washington? An Exposition of Romans #11 Romans 13:1-7

How do we as followers of Jesus Christ - who are bound for the Promised Land - live, function and relate to secular government and authority? This isn't an easy question to answer. But we must struggle to find one. In today's message, I'll provide you with some biblical principles from Romans 13:1-7 and in other passages of Scripture that will help you answer the question in your own heart.

- 1. Jesus Christ has ordained government as a good thing. But he also set it's limits. (Rom 13:1, 6-7; Matt 22:19-21)
 - · Caesar had his image on certain things and they rightly belonged to him
 - i. Taxes
 - ii. Respect
 - iii. Honor
 - But you are from God's mint; your use is determined by the likeness you bear
 - i. Will
 - ii. Intellect
 - iii. Soul
- 2. The God of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and Jesus sets up all governments even the bad ones and takes them down (Rom 13:1; Gn 12:1-3)
 - The Prophetic Paradigm of Abraham's Covenant Still Bearing Fruit (Gn 12:1-3)
 - Therefore, the proper response of "People of the Book" is to always start with why
- 3. We too often ignore government or participate as little as possible in it because of mistaken beliefs (Dan 2:21)
 - A Mistaken Theological Belief: When we become citizens of Heaven by faith we cease to be citizens of secular kingdoms.
 - A Mistaken Cultural Belief: The secular and the sacred are different and must be separated.
 - The Right Belief: There is no difference between the secular and sacred in God's domain.
- 4. Our dual citizenship can create a great dilemma (Rom 13:2-5; Acts 4:18-20)
 - Between the command of Romans 13:2-5
 - And the rebellion of Acts 4:18-20







