A Note from Pastor Derrick

The Narrow Road Between Judging and Naivety
The Sermon on the Mount #10
Matt 7:1-6

Have you ever met a person who talks about Jesus a lot AND has the unspiritual gift of condemning nearly everyone and everything they see that's wrong at the same time? Such an approach to Christianity lacks...well...Christ. On the other hand, have you ever met an individual who struggles with enabling someone who doesn't need to be enabled? This approach to Christianity lacks discernment. Both are destructive paths. Today, we explore what lies at the end of these extreme roads. We will also look down the narrow road between the two extremes: The road of Jesus. What road are you on?

The Wide Road of Judging Others

1. Replacement of God's Character as the final standard with one's opinion.
 - a. Making a pronouncement of another's guilt before God.
 - b. Comes with a double portion of judgment by God for the pronouncer.
2. Forces love out of relationships and hypocrisy into them.
 - a. Equals handling things wrong 100 percent of the time.
 - b. Equals a lack of humility and a lack of self-evaluation.
 - c. Results in blindness

The Wide Road of Naive Acceptance

1. Investing your precious heavenly commodities in people who care nothing for them.
 - a. Pearls = Valuable Kingdom of God
 - b. Dogs and Swine = No Regard for What You Value
2. Comes when we confuse being judgmental with making wise judgments.
 - a. Judgmental Person = Opening the soul of a person and shaking your head in disgust
 - b. Making Wise Judgments = Discerning safety and danger and acting upon it

The Narrow Road of Jesus

1. Judge not -- because what you condemn in others is true of you.
2. Be as wise as serpents and harmless as doves.
