A Prayer of Comfort For This Reason, I Kneel: Seven Prayers of Paul #1 2 Cor 1:3-7

The late great Methodist preacher Samuel Chadwick once said this about prayer:

"The one concern of the devil is to keep Christians from praying. He fears nothing from prayerless studies, prayerless work, and prayerless religion. He laughs at our toil and mocks our wisdom. But he <u>trembles</u> when we pray."

The more I read about the great saints of the Scriptures, the more convinced I am that their greatest strengths were not their talents, abilities or skill sets. It was their prayer life. The Apostle Paul is such an example. His NT letters contain a whopping <u>forty-one</u> prayers. In this series, we study 7 I've identified that will certainly be helpful and practical to you.

My prayer for you in this series is you learn to make the devil tremble in your personal prayers

and in your supplications for Genesis Church. We start today with Paul's Prayer of Comfort to

the Corinthians.

A Prayer of Comfort Acknowledges

- 1. Jesus is committed to save and sustain his people, no matter what (1:3)
 - a. The Father of Compassion
 - b. The God of All Comfort
- 2. Jesus faithfulness demonstrated to me should be passed on to others (1:4).
 - a. Though Paul comforted others
 - b. Jesus is the one to be praised because he set the example
- 3. Jesus never allows our afflictions to outweigh his consolations (1:5).
 - a. Afflictions of Paul (2 Cor 4:8-9)
 - i. Circumstantial "pressed on every side"
 - ii. Mental "perplexed"
 - iii. Physical "persecuted" and "struck down"
 - b. Consolations of Jesus (2 Cor 4:8-9)
 - i. Circumstantial "but not crushed"
 - ii. Mental "but not in despair"
 - iii. Physical "but not abandoned" and "not destroyed"
- 4. Why Jesus chooses to save and sustain us in the first place (1:6-7)
 - a. Endurance
 - b. Hope
