

The Table Waiter That Changed the World The Story of the Non-Apostle, Ordinary Fella named Stephen Acts 6-7

"Wait a minute, preacher. I thought you were preaching through 1 John?" I am and we will continue our journey through that phenomenal epistle when next we gather at the river. But I've been going through the Book of Acts in my private time with the Lord and teaching through it on Tuesday evening. And there's one person in it I can't get off my mind. His story has a lot to tell us about who God uses to perform - by far - his greatest works. Here's a hint: they are not professional ministers or hired holy men.

Why Stephen?

- Servant: Gospel advances, church grows, people's lives are changed via servanthood(6:1-5)
 - a. <u>Consumer Christianity</u>: "what's in it for me" = modeled after the world = church hopping mentality
 - b. <u>Servanthood Christianity</u>: "how can I serve you, Lord, and others" = modeled by Jesus = bloom where God plants you mentality
- 2. Ordinary: Ordinary people, not preachers, are the greatest Gospel advancing, church growing, and life changing force this world has ever seen (6: 8-10)
 - a. Number of Apostles Featured in Acts 6-7: One (7:58)
 - b. Number of Ordinary People in Acts 6-7: One
- 3. Thy Word: Serving others opened doors. But the Word of God was more important than his own life (7: 1-2))
 - a. Longest sermon by someone not named Jesus in NT
 - b. Sermon world had no counter argument for (7:52, 60)
 - c. Sermon hidden in heart long before occasion
- 4. Self-Denial: Most effective contribution to the kingdom came via self-denial, not self-interest (7:55)
 - a. Jesus seated at the right hand of God = the NT expression
 - b. Jesus standing at the right hand of God = only used here


