Discern. Test. Evaluate.


Redeeming Simplicity: An Exposition of 1st John #9

1 John 4:1-6

We've come to the critical turning point passage in the Epistle of 1 John; one that begins the application of the simple truths about Jesus, fellowship, and love that we've just studied in the first three chapters. With this passage, John switches to the application portion of his letter.

How can we live victoriously and love others the way Jesus loved us? John's answer to this question isn't what you would expect. He doesn't start with prayer or Bible reading; both of which are important. He starts with one concept: discernment.

- 1. What is discernment? (4:1a)
 - "The ability to correctly judge what is beneficial for obtaining Christian guidance and understanding"
 - The type of judgment the Lord abhors
 - The type of judgment the Lord approves
 - Examples Bereans (Acts 17:11; Ephesians (Rev. 2:2)
- 2. Why discernment? (4:1b)
 - b/c it intersects the Christian life in a fallen world at every point
 - b/c it forces you to protect and maintain your Christian freedom
- 3. How to practice it? (2-3, 5)
 - The Motivation Test Can I be at peace with what the Lord shows me?
 - The Jesus Test How is the character of Jesus magnified in this?
 - The Apostolic Test What NT principle is illustrated in my decision?
- 4. What happens when you start practicing discernment? (4)
 - · One word: overcome
