## A Message from Pastor Derrick

## Last Hour Theology Redeeming Simplicity: 1 John #4 1 John 2: 18-29

"Derrick, do you think we are living in the End Times that Jesus talks about?" "Yes. I do. We have been for the last 2000 years." "What do you mean?"

We answer that question today, my friends, in the fourth sermon of the Redeeming Simplicity Series in our study of 1st John. If the last hour was this hour, would you be eager to stand before

Him?

- 1. The Anti-Christ will come; but Anti-Christs are already here (18-19; 22-23)
  - a. Anti-Christ Singular
    - i. How He's Referenced (2 Thess. 2; Dan. 7-8; Rev. 13)
    - ii. How He Will Operate
  - b. Anti-Christs Plural
    - i. Disguise and Deception
    - ii. Hostility and Combativeness to Apostolic Message (N.T.)
    - iii. Jesus Created In Own Image
    - iv. Attitudes and Viewpoint Evangelized
- 2. Jesus will come; and Jesus is already here (20-21)
  - a. A Messianic Title About Jesus "Holy One"
  - b. A Messianic Title About You "Anointed"
  - c. How Holy One (Jesus) and Anointed (You) Operate "Truth"
  - d. The Barabbas Example
- 3. I'm in the battle between fact and fiction whether I want to be or not (24-27)
  - a. How to be on the wrong side of it
    - i. Substitute another's walk with Jesus for your own
    - ii. Consider church worship and fellowship with Christians unimportant
    - iii. When you see a need and opportunity to minister to others, wait for someone else to take the initiative
    - iv. Let anger and unforgiveness define your relationships
  - b. How to be on the right side of it "see to it" "remain in him"
- 4. I don't fear his coming as my Righteous Judge (28-29)
  - a. Confident certainty about my legal standing before God
  - b. Unashamed not embarrassed or conscious about moral guilt

## One More Thing...

A Godly Heart Psalms 37:1-8

The Lord promises to give us the desires of our hearts. But many people take this passage out of context, forgetting that their own mindset plays a vital part in bringing it to fruition. As my mother once said, "Where your mind goes, your feet go, so be careful what you think about."

What is your responsibility when it comes to claiming promises from God?

Delight yourselves in the Lord (Ps. 37:4). Christians should rejoice in God and desire to walk in obedience. The Lord must have first place in your life before you can claim the promise in this verse.

Commit your way to the Lord (v. 5). Allow God to change any aspect of your ambition that is not His will.

Remember that when He doesn't answer a prayer as you wished, it is for a reason.

Trust in Him (v. 5). God is merciful, all-knowing, kind, and generous. You can trust Him with your hopes and dreams.

Rest in Him (v. 7). Resting in the Lord means trusting Him to answer prayers in His timing or transform your aspirations so they conform to His will.

Wait upon the Lord patiently (v. 7). Jesus waited three decades before beginning His three-year ministry on earth. According to His example, waiting is one of the key principles of Christian living.

Do your desires align with God's purpose and plan for your life? He longs to give His followers abundant blessings and fullness of joy.
