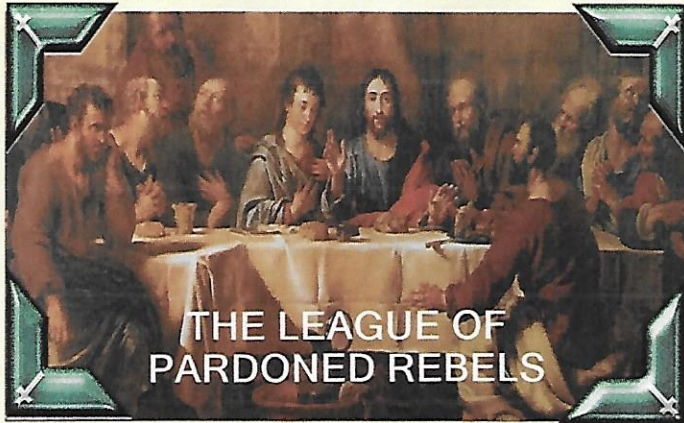

PART I: SIMON PETER

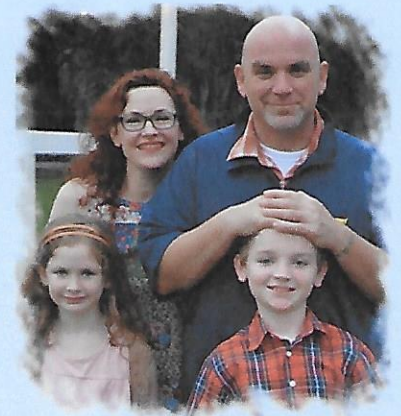

They were the League of Pardoned Rebels and this is their story. And it's yours too.

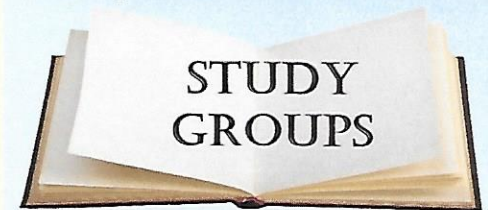

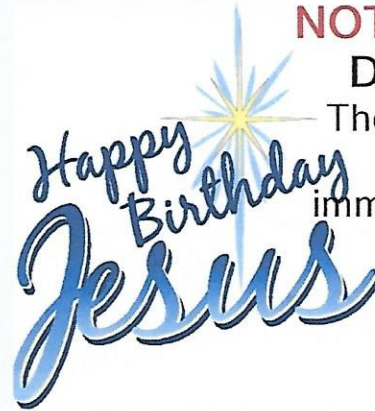
