Last Hour Theology
Redeeming Simplicity: 1 John #4
1 John 2:28-3:3

Most of us have gone to church long enough to know we have our own lexicon: the one that features a list of phrases we like to speak to other Christians. We speak them often and assume others know what we are talking about, don't we? Phrases like: "Hey sister." "I'm praying for you." "He has a servants heart."

My favorite one is the simplest: "God loves me." I say it often; but, don't usually stop and consider the reasons I say it. That's what I love about John. He makes a statement: "How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God" (1 John 3:1)! Then he makes sure to tell us why it's true with a sense of wonder and amazement. And, we learn that today from 1 John 2:28-3:3.

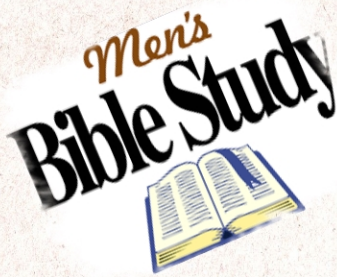


OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

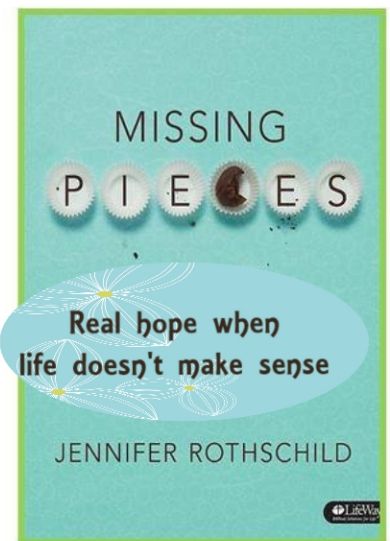
