**The Christian and Sin**  
**Redeeming Simplicity: An Exposition of 1 John #6**  
**1 John 3:4-10**

The late great preacher, John Stott, proclaimed many years ago that “sin and the child of God are incompatible. They may occasionally meet; but they cannot live together in harmony.”

We’ll see how true this statement is today from 1 John 3:4-10.

**I. Sin is missing the mark of the standard of God. (4)**

- it’s inherited
- It’s commission
- It’s omission

**II. Jesus came to defeat the penalty, power, and presence of sin in our lives. (5, 8a)**

- “And you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.” (Mt. 1:21)
- “Look, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world” (Jn 1:29)
- “For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins” (Col 1:13-14)
- “Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners-of whom I am the worst” (1 Tim 1:15)

**III. Continuing to do as a lifestyle what you know misses the mark undermines the purpose of our Lord’s first coming. (9)**

- When I see this in my life, I:
  - o Meditate on why he died - (1 Cor 15:3)
  - o Pray the sufficiency of the blood over my life - (1 Pt 1:18-19)

**IV. Living mindfully that the fruit reveals the root will produce self-control and Christ-exalting patterns in our lives (10)**

- If I think of love, I’m inclined to love....the same with joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness and self-control.
