

He went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when evening was come, he was there alone (Matthew 14:23).



The man Christ Jesus felt the need of perfect solitude--Himself alone, entirely by Himself, alone with Himself. The man Christ Jesus knew this, too, and felt the need of being by Himself again, of gathering all His powers, of realizing fully His high destiny, His human weakness, His entire dependence on the Father.

If ever there was one who could dispense with special seasons for solitude and fellowship, it was our Lord.
