Message from Pastor Derrick

The Message in the Myrrh An Exposition of Revelation #4 Revelation 2:8-11

In the language of the New Testament, "Smyrna" translates to "myrrh"; a gift given to our Lord to foreshadow his trials and tribulations.

The Lessons in the Myrrh

(1) There's a blessing in bad situations

- (a) The Drastic Contrasts First and Last (8); Died and came to life again (8); afflictions and poverty, yet rich (9); faithful to death and I will give you victor's crown (10); victorious not hurt by 2nd death (11)
- (b) How to See Them
- (i) Don't be consumed in your thought life by the situation obsessing does nothing to control it (Phil 4:6)
- (ii) Smallest blessings are worthy of your utmost attention (Ex 23:30)
- (iii) Associate with joyful people. The more you do, the more you learn to count your blessings as they do (Phil 1:4)
- (iv) The sun doesn't change. It's what comes between us and the sun that effects how we react to it.

(2) The easiest correction is the hardest to practice: Do not Fear what lies ahead (10a).

(a) Over 70 "Do not fears" in the Bible

Most within the context of heavenly encounters (Luke 2:10). Here though, don't be afraid of impending hardship

- (b) Why we fear what lies ahead:
- (i) Correlation between what lies ahead and past experiences (Why Paul says the least of the apostle's)
- (ii) Obstacles ahead are dangerous and treacherous (Num 13 There's giants in the land)
- (iii) Obstacles ahead are unfamiliar (Moses).
- (c) So why inform Symrna of what lies ahead?
- (i) What lies ahead demands faithfulness to traverse
- (ii) Some stands you have to make in life are more important than life itself

(3) Prepare best for future tests by passing the ones given in the present

A harkening back to test of Daniel and his friend's (Daniel 1). The Victor's crown and the wreath - Smyrna home to Olympic games; wreathes in their city monuments to symbolize Roman might.

(a) Difference between test and temptation

Test - God; Temptation - Devil

Test - Demonstrate Faith; Temptation - Lead Astray

Test - Perseverance is a must; Temptation - Resist

Test - God's says his name is in us; Temptation - the Flesh is Weak

Test - Glory of Proven Character; Temptation - Spiritual, and or physical, death

Test - Must not shrink back; Temptation - must not fall into

- (b) Why tests are important
- (i) Faithfulness in small tests now will directly impact the behavior patterns you demonstrate in the future.
- (ii) Every test passed, no matter how small or large, comes with a victor's crown of some type.

**(4) Supply of strength we have is greater than the trial

- (a) Why It's Greater
- (i) Because it's providentially designed First and Last (8)
- (ii) Because someone's gone before you Death and Resurrection (8)
- (iii) Because we know our ultimate destiny victorious will not be hurt by 2nd death (11)
